IMPROVING COMMUNITY HEALTHCARE BY IMPROVING PARISH NURSING QUALITY THROUGH EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICE

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Around the globe, our healthcare systems are less able to meet the wholistic health needs of people. Reform is needed. Parish nurses have a role to play.

This presentation is the result of a comprehensive review of the research literature for parish nursing published between 2008-2020. Studies were reviewed and appraised using the Mixed Method Assessment Tool (MMAT)₁. The themes of practice roles of the parish nurse (PN), role implementation, and program evaluation research, as well as gaps and opportunities for research, were identified.

Our research provides evidence of:

- the value of parish nurses (PNs) in improving wholistic health promotion and navigation
- opportunities to engage PNs in research and evidence-based practice (EBP) and advancing the impact of PN practice through research
